

# **Wandlebury Country Park Rules**

**Please read and follow these rules**

They make this park a happy and safe place for everyone to visit and help protect the sites archaeology and wildlife.

- **Cars, motorbikes & other motorised vehicles (except buggies for people with disabilities) must only use the visitor car park/disabled parking area**
- **Camping and overnight stays of any person or vehicle are not permitted**
- **Dogs must be kept under strict control and on leads at all times, to protect our wildlife, sheep, cattle and fellow visitors**
- **Clean up after your dogs – please use the bins provided**
- **Supervise children at all times and be considerate to other visitors**
- **Please keep to the designated paths through the woods and close gates**
- **Please do not enter meadows where cattle and sheep are grazing**
- **Please do not feed the cattle, sheep or wildlife**
- **No cycling is allowed through the park except for children under 8 years when accompanied by an adult. Please use the cycle racks**
- **Horse riding is not allowed**
- **Please be quiet near any residential properties**
- **Please be careful near unfenced areas of open water – no swimming, boating or fishing**
- **Enjoy the wildlife but do not pick flowers, fruit, disturb wild animals or interfere with wildlife in any way**
- **The use of metal detectors is strictly forbidden because the park is a Scheduled Ancient Monument**
- **No open fires are permitted anywhere on site**
- **Drones are not permitted to fly over the Park**
- **No barbeques are permitted, unless the designated BBQ area is pre-booked with the office**
- **Den building only in the den building area by the BBQ site please**
- **To ensure they can be accommodated and any appropriate arrangements made, Organised Groups are requested to register their visit to the park in advance.**
- **Please keep the park tidy – take your litter home or use the bins provided**
